On p. 47 of Aviation Week, 20 July 1959, is a note about GSA offering 110 USAF C-46's for sale within the next 60 days for \$50,000-\$60,000 each.

There are 2 reasons why the AFMuseum could be interested in obtaining one:

- (1) Availability of a historical aircraft.
- (2) The C-46 played a prominent part in the over-the-hump operations of WW II. Albeit troublesome and requiring a great deal of maintenance, it nevertheless had made numerous trips over the hump. It was used by USAF because it had the greatest cargo capacity of all transports then available. ~~and~~ ~~was~~ Some 3,000 of them had been bought by USAAF.
